



PRODUCTION TRAINING BY YULA LOVEN

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To maintain a professional and supportive learning environment, all students participating in the Production Training Program are expected to review and follow the Terms and Conditions outlined below:

1. EDUCATIONAL PURPOSE DISCLAIMER

1.1 Educational Use

This program is intended for educational and professional development purposes only. Participation in the program does not guarantee employment, internships, or placement within the animation industry.

1.2 Internship Opportunities

Students who complete the program may become eligible to apply for internship opportunities connected to EVOL Motions.. Internship selection is based on project availability, student performance, and studio needs, and participation is not guaranteed.

2. CLASS ATTENDANCE

1.1 Group Assignment

Students are required to attend the class group and schedule they originally signed up for. Switching freely between different groups or class days is not permitted.

2.2 Missed Classes

If a student is unable to attend due to unexpected circumstances, they may request to join another group or attend during a future training cycle. Such requests will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and are not guaranteed.

2.3 Punctuality

Students are expected to arrive on time for each class. All lectures begin at their scheduled start time, and late arrivals accept responsibility for any missed material or activities.

2.4 Student Conduct

Students are expected to maintain respectful and professional behavior throughout the program. Harassment, discrimination, disruptive conduct, or inappropriate behavior toward instructors or fellow students may result in removal from the program without refund.

3. PROGRAM PARTICIPATION

3.1 Onboarding

All students will receive onboarding information approximately one week prior to the program start date.

3.2 Discord Communication

Students are not required to join the private Discord server; however, important updates, announcements, and communication may be shared primarily through this platform. Students who choose not to join accept responsibility for potentially missing program-related information.

3.3 Online Classes

All classes will be conducted via Google Meet.

3.4 Schedule Changes

In rare circumstances, the instructor reserves the right to reschedule, postpone, or cancel a class due to emergencies, technical issues, or unforeseen circumstances. In such cases, students will be informed as early as possible and appropriate alternatives or compensation will be considered.

3.5 Age Requirement

Students under the age of 18 must have parental or guardian permission to participate in the program

3.6 Homework Participation

All students are expected to participate in the group homework assignment following Class 3. If a student is unable to participate due to personal reasons, they must inform the instructor in advance.

4. CERTIFICATES

4.1 Eligibility

Certificates are issued only to students who complete the program attendance requirements.

4.2 Certificate Requests

Certificates are issued upon individual request. Students interested in receiving a certificate must contact the instructor following program completion.

5. REFUND POLICY

5.1 Refund Window

Students are eligible for a full refund within 3 days of purchase.

5.2 Refund Restrictions

After the 3-day refund period has passed, refunds are no longer available.

5.3 Transfer Requests

If a student becomes unable to attend the program due to unforeseen circumstances after the refund period, they may request to transfer their enrollment to a future training cycle. Transfer requests are reviewed individually and approval is not guaranteed.

6. NDA & CONFIDENTIALITY

6.1 NDA Requirement

All students are required to sign a Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) prior to attending Class 3 and Class 4.

6.2 Failure to Submit NDA

Students who fail to submit the signed NDA before Class 3 may lose access to the remaining classes and will not be eligible for a refund.

6.3 Recording & Redistribution

Recording, sharing, or redistributing class content is strictly prohibited. Students will receive selected after-class materials, and certain slides, charts, or templates may be provided upon request.
